TITLE: CONCERNING COLLEGE PREPARATORY COURSES IN HIGH SCHOOLS.

Summary of Assessment

This bill requires each school district board of education to adopt a policy providing for:

- notice to a student's parent or legal guardian of the student's likely need for additional college preparation based on the results of the eleventh-grade ACT; and
- an adequate supply of courses in high school to permit a student who needs additional preparation to receive it prior to high school graduation.

It is assumed that any cost associated with providing notice to parents can be absorbed within the operating budgets of public high schools. Therefore, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact. The bill will become effective upon signature of the Governor.
