A BILL FOR AN ACT CONCERNING THE REQUIREMENT THAT SIGNATURES ON PETITIONS SEEKING TO REIMPOSE PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION REGULATION OVER COOPERATIVE ELECTRIC ASSOCIATIONS BE COLLECTED FROM MEMBER-CONSUMERS WITHIN A SPECIFIED PERIOD.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not necessarily reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted.)

Requires that signatures on petitions seeking to reimpose public utility commission regulation over cooperative electric associations be collected from member-consumers within a specified period.

2 **SECTION 1.** 40-9.5-113, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

40-9.5-113. Method of reimposing public utilities commission **regulation.** Any cooperative electric association may vote no more than once a year to place said association under the regulation of the public utilities commission, as provided in the "Public Utilities Law", articles 1 to 7 of this title. Said question shall only be submitted to the members and consumers MEMBER-CONSUMERS of a cooperative electric THE association if at least five percent of the members and consumers MEMBER-CONSUMERS of the association sign a petition requesting such an election AND IF SUCH SIGNATURES ARE GATHERED WITHIN A SIX-MONTH PERIOD IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING THE SUBMISSION OF THE PETITION TO THE ASSOCIATION'S BOARD OF DIRECTORS. Such petition shall be submitted to, and signatures certified by, the association's board of directors at a regular scheduled meeting. SUCH CERTIFICATION SHALL INCLUDE A DETERMINATION AS TO WHETHER THE SIGNATURES ON THE PETITION WERE GATHERED WITHIN A SIX-MONTH PERIOD IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING THE SUBMISSION OF THE PETITION TO THE BOARD. After the petition has been certified by the board, the public utilities commission shall conduct an election within forty-five days on the question. If a majority of the persons voting at the election vote in favor of placing their association under public utilities commission regulation, the commission shall reassert its regulation upon determination of the election results.
