TITLE: CONCERNING PARENTAL NOTIFICATION OF POSTSECONDARY EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES.**Summary of Assessment**

This bill requires each school district board of education in the state to adopt a policy for the provision of notice to parents and legal guardians of high school students concerning:

- the Colorado Commission on Higher Education's pre-collegiate curriculum;
- potential financial liabilities if a student later needs remedial education; and
- the availability of information regarding financial assistance to attend a four-year college or university.

The bill directs the parent or legal guardian to acknowledge receipt of the notice and communicate to the school either that the parent or legal guardian is in agreement with the student's decision not to enroll in the pre-collegiate curriculum or that the parent or legal guardian will work with the school to enroll the student in the pre-collegiate curriculum.

The bill will not affect state or school district revenues or expenditures, and is therefore assessed as having no fiscal impact. The bill will become effective August 10, 2005, unless a referendum petition is filed.
