A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING EXTENSION OF THE SURCHARGE ASSOCIATED WITH THE
102 SECURITY FEATURES FOUND ON DRIVERS' LICENSES.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not necessarily reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted.)

Extends the 60¢ surcharge on drivers' licenses that covers the cost of security features.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** 42-2-114 (2) (a) (I) (F), Colorado Revised Statutes,

2 **42-2-114. License issued - fees - repeal.** (2) (a) (I) Except as
3 provided in subsection (3) of this section:

4 (F) In addition to the fees imposed in sub-subparagraphs (A) to
5 (D) of this subparagraph (I), the fee for the issuance of a minor driver's
6 or driver's license shall include a sixty-cent surcharge. ~~Such THE MONEYS~~
7 ~~COLLECTED PURSUANT TO THE~~ surcharge shall be forwarded to the
8 department for transmission to THE state treasurer, who shall credit the
9 same to the identification security fund created in section 42-1-220. ~~This~~
10 ~~sub-subparagraph (F) is repealed, effective July 1, 2006.~~

11 **SECTION 2. Repeal.** 42-1-220 (3), Colorado Revised Statutes,
12 is repealed as follows:

13 **42-1-220. Identification security fund.** (3) ~~This section is~~

15 **SECTION 3. Repeal.** 42-2-306 (1) (a) (V) (B), Colorado
16 Revised Statutes, is repealed as follows:

17 **42-2-306. Fees - disposition - repeal.** (1) The department shall

21 **SECTION 4. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
22 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
23 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
