TITLE: CONCERNING EXTENSION OF THE SURCHARGE ASSOCIATED WITH THE SECURITY FEATURES FOUND ON DRIVERS' LICENSES.

Summary of Assessment

The bill allows for the extension of the \$0.60 surcharge on the issuance of all drivers' licenses and identification (ID) cards that was scheduled to end July 1, 2006 until July 1, 2009. Under current law, the Department of Revenue imposes this surcharge to enhance the security of drivers' licenses and ID cards. These moneys are credited to the Identification Security Fund within the Highway Users Tax Fund. The bill also extends this fund and the report on the fund from the Office of the State Auditor to the Transportation Legislation Review Committee.

The bill is not expected to affect state or local government revenues or expenditures beyond the current level. The department collected roughly \$508,000 in FY 2003-04, \$529,000 in FY 2004-05, and \$522,000 in FY 2005-06. Because the bill continues an existing program, it is assessed as having no fiscal impact. It became effective April 24, 2006, upon the signature of the Governor.
