After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB06-1283 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 7, line 17, strike "SEVENTY-FIVE" and  
2 substitute "SIXTY-FIVE".

3 Page 11, strike lines 7 through 9 and substitute the following:

4           **"SECTION 4. Refer to people under referendum.** This act  
5 shall be submitted to a vote of the registered electors of the state of  
6 Colorado at the next biennial regular general election, for their approval  
7 or rejection, under the provisions of the referendum as provided for in  
8 section 1 of article V of the state constitution, and in article 40 of title 1,  
9 Colorado Revised Statutes. Each elector voting at said election and  
10 desirous of voting for or against said act shall cast a vote as provided by  
11 law either "Yes" or "No" on the proposition: "SHALL COLORADO STATE  
12 LAW REQUIRE THAT IN EACH STATE FISCAL YEAR A SCHOOL DISTRICT  
13 SPEND AT LEAST SIXTY-FIVE PERCENT OF ITS OPERATIONAL EXPENDITURES  
14 ON SERVICES THAT DIRECTLY AFFECT STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT?" The  
15 votes cast for the adoption or rejection of said act shall be canvassed and  
16 the result determined in the manner provided by law for the canvassing  
17 of votes for representatives in Congress."
