HB06S-1020 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 3, line 25, strike "OR REASONABLY SHOULD
- 2 HAVE KNOWN".
- 3 Page 4, line 8, strike "PRIOR TO JANUARY";
- 4 strike line 9 and substitute the following:
- 5 "BEFORE THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS PARAGRAPH (b);";
- 6 line 19, after "**referendum.**", insert "(1)";
- 7 line 27, strike "\_\_\_\_\_" and substitute "ONE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND
- 8 DOLLARS".
- 9 Page 5, line 8, strike "OR REASONABLY SHOULD HAVE KNOWN";
- 10 after line 17, insert the following:
- 11 "(2) In accordance with section 1-5-407 (5), Colorado Revised
- 12 Statutes, it is the intent of the general assembly that this act, as a measure
- 13 to increase taxes, be printed on the ballot immediately following all
- 14 constitutional referred measures and before any other statutory referred
- 15 measures and lettered accordingly."
- 16 Page 1, line 108, strike "OR";

1 line 109, strike "REASONABLY SHOULD HAVE KNOWN".
