- 4 (2) Now, therefore, it is the intent of the general ASSEMBLY THAT THE WEB-BASED SYSTEM ESTABLISHED BY THE GOVERNOR'S EXECUTIVE ORDER BE MODIFIED AS SET FORTH IN THIS ARTICLE.
- 8 **24-72.4-102. Definitions.** As used in this article, unless the 9 CONTEXT OTHERWISE REQUIRES:
- 10 (1) "CHIEF INFORMATION OFFICER" MEANS THE CHIEF INFORMATION OFFICER APPOINTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 24-37.5-103.
- 12 (2) "Web-based system" means the searchable web-based 13 system that provides access to descriptions of revenues and 14 expenditures recorded in the state's official book of record 15 that, in accordance with executive order 007-09, is developed 16 and maintained by the chief information officer, in consultation 17 with the state controller.
- 18 **24-72.4-103. Web-based system enhancements.** (1) NOLATER 19 THAN JANUARY 1, 2010, THE CHIEF INFORMATION OFFICER SHALL MODIFY 20 THE WEB-BASED SYSTEM TO MEET THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:
- 21 (a) THE STATE EXPENDITURES AND REVENUES DATA INCLUDED IN
  22 THE WEB-BASED SYSTEM SHALL BE THE EXPENDITURE AND REVENUE DATA
  23 INCLUDED IN THE STATE FINANCIAL SYSTEM DATABASE, COMMONLY
  24 KNOWN AS THE FINANCIAL DATA WAREHOUSE, CREATED BY THE OFFICE OF
  25 INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY ON BEHALF OF THE STATE CONTROLLER
  26 PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY SET FORTH IN SECTION 24-30-202;
- 27 (b) THE WEB-BASED SYSTEM SHALL BE ACCESSIBLE FROM THE WEB
  28 SITE MAINTAINED BY THE STATE, AND EACH STATE AGENCY WITH A WEB
  29 SITE SHALL PROVIDE A LINK ON THE WEB SITE HOME PAGE TO THE SYSTEM;
- 30 (c) THE INFORMATION ON THE WEB-BASED SYSTEM SHALL BE
  31 UPDATED EVERY FIVE BUSINESS DAYS TO INCLUDE NEW EXPENDITURE AND
  32 REVENUE DATA;

- 4 (e) THE WEB-BASED SYSTEM SHALL INCLUDE A METHOD FOR USERS
  5 TO PROVIDE FEEDBACK ABOUT THE SYSTEM; AND

  7 AND EXPENDITURE DATA FOR THE TEN PRIOR STATE FISCAL YEARS; EXCEPT
  8 THAT NO DATA SHALL BE REQUIRED FOR ANY STATE FISCAL YEAR PRIOR TO
  9 JULY 1, 2009, AND, FOR THE 2009-10 STATE FISCAL YEAR ONLY, NO STATE
  10 REVENUE DATA SHALL BE REQUIRED TO BE ARCHIVED.
- 11 SECTION 2 Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 12 shall take effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 13 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly that is 14 allowed for submitting a referendum petition pursuant to article V, 15 section 1 (3) of the state constitution, (August 4, 2009, if adjournment sine die is on May 6, 2009); except that, if a referendum petition is filed 16 against this act or an item, section, or part of this act within such period, 17 18 then the act, item, section, or part, if approved by the people, shall take 19 effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by 20 proclamation of the governor.".
