After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB09-232 be amended as follows:

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 3, line 2, after "34-63-102", insert "(5) (a)
2 (I) and";

3 line 3, strike "is amended" and substitute "are amended, and the said
4 34-63-102 (5) (a) is further amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW
5 SUBPARAGRAPH,";

6 after line 5, insert the following:

7 "(5) (a) (I) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (IV) OF THIS
8 PARAGRAPH (a), before July 1, 2008, the remaining fifteen percent of all
9 moneys described in paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of this section, any
10 moneys received pursuant to subparagraph (II) of paragraph (b) of
11 subsection (3) of this section, and any moneys received pursuant to
12 subparagraph (II) of paragraph (c) of subsection (3) of this section shall,
13 upon receipt, be paid into the local government mineral impact fund,
14 which is hereby created. Before July 1, 2008, the executive director of
15 the department of local affairs shall distribute said moneys from the fund
16 pursuant to subsection (3) of this section; except that the remainder
17 provided for in this paragraph (a) shall be distributed in accordance with
18 the purposes and priorities described in subsection (1) of this section. On
19 and after July 1, 2008, moneys shall be paid into the fund as specified in
20 paragraph (b) of subsection (5.4) of this section and distributed as
21 specified in paragraphs (b) and (c) of said subsection. Notwithstanding
22 any other provision of this paragraph (a) or subsection (5.5) of this
23 section, in the fiscal years commencing July 1, 2006, July 1, 2007, July
24 1, 2008, July 1, 2009, and July 1, 2010, the executive director of the



1 department of local affairs shall transfer three million two hundred fifty
2 thousand dollars of the moneys in the fund to the state treasurer, who
3 shall credit the moneys to the wildfire preparedness fund created in
4 section 23-31-309 (4), C.R.S.

5 (IV) ONE HUNDRED PERCENT OF THE MONEYS CREDITED TO THE
6 LOCAL GOVERNMENT MINERAL IMPACT FUND CREATED IN SUBPARAGRAPH
7 (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH (a) BY OPERATION OF SUB-SUBPARAGRAPH (C) OF
8 SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF PARAGRAPH (a) OF SUBSECTION (5.3) OF THIS
9 SECTION SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED BY THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE
10 DEPARTMENT OF LOCAL AFFAIRS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PURPOSES AND
11 PRIORITIES DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1) OF THIS SECTION, AND IN
12 DISTRIBUTING SUCH MONEYS THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR SHALL GIVE
13 PRIORITY TO THOSE COMMUNITIES MOST DIRECTLY AND SUBSTANTIALLY
14 IMPACTED BY PRODUCTION OF ENERGY RESOURCES ON FEDERAL MINERAL
15 LANDS AND TO GRANT APPLICATIONS THAT:

16 (A) ARE SUBMITTED JOINTLY BY MULTIPLE LOCAL GOVERNMENTS;
17 OR

18 (B) SEEK FUNDING FOR A PROJECT THAT IS A
19 MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL PROJECT OR THAT REQUIRES A SUBSTANTIAL
20 AMOUNT OF FUNDING."

21 Page 4, line 27, strike "SEVERANCE".

22 Page 5, line 1, strike "TAX" and substitute "MINERAL IMPACT" and strike
23 "SECTION 39-29-110, C.R.S.," and substitute "SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF
24 PARAGRAPH (a) OF SUBSECTION (5) OF THIS SECTION";

25 line 2, strike "SECTION 39-29-110 (1) (c.7), C.R.S." and substitute
26 "SUBPARAGRAPH (IV) OF PARAGRAPH (a) OF SUBSECTION (5) OF THIS
27 SECTION.";

28 strike lines 3 through 27.

29 Page 6, strike lines 1 through 19.

30 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.

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
