SHORT TITLE: "Permanently Fund Water Efficiency Grants"

A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING THE LONG-TERM FUNDING OF THE WATER EFFICIENCY
102 GRANT PROGRAM.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not necessarily reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted.)

Water Resources Review Committee. The water efficiency grant program is currently scheduled to be repealed on July 1, 2012. Section 1 of the bill extends the program indefinitely. Section 2 authorizes up to \$550,000 of annual appropriations from the cash fund beginning on July 1, 2010. Section 3 annually transfers \$550,000 from tier 2 of the operational account of the severance tax trust fund to the water efficiency grant program cash fund beginning on July 1, 2012.

Commencing July 1, 2008, the general 22 assembly shall also appropriate from the fund to the board fifty thousand dollars each fiscal year through 2011-12 to cover the costs associated 23 24 with the administration of the grant program and the requirements of section 37-60-124. Moneys appropriated pursuant to this subparagraph 25 26 (III) shall remain available until expended. or until June 30, 2012.
