HB09-1290 National Guard Tuition Assistance

- 1. Tuition Assistance (TA) is the primary state recruiting incentive for the Colorado National Guard.
- 2. Currently we have 5051 member in the Colorado Air & Army National Guard
- 3. In the last 12 months DMVA provided support for 628 semesters of state TA which exhausted our appropriation of \$825,803.
- 4. DMVA had to defer payment of 136 semesters of state TA into FY 2008-09 (\$152,238).
- 5. In order to not exceed our \$825,803 in FY2008-09 DMVA has rationed the state TA at 80% of tuition for Spring 09 and no funding for Summer 09.
- 6. The Joint Budget Committee, during figure setting, approved a General Fund increase in DMVA state TA funding from \$175,803 to \$246,157.
- 7. This legislation would increase the transfer from Higher Education's Tuition Assistance from the current \$650,000 to \$800,000 providing a total appropriation of \$1,046,157.
- 8. This very closely matches the anticipated need for FY2009-10 which is 745 semesters of state TA for a total anticipated cost (@100% tuition) of \$1,140,595 (avg \$1,531/semester).
- 9. The increase from \$650,000 to \$800,000 has been approved by the Governor's Office of State Planning & Budgeting and the Department of Higher Education.
