After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB09-1039 be amended as follows:

1 Amend the reengrossed bill, page 2, before line 1, insert the following:

2 "SECTION 1. 23-7-103 (1) (c) (I) (C), Colorado Revised
3 Statutes, is amended to read:

4 **23-7-103. Presumptions and rules for determination of status.**

5 (1) Unless the contrary appears to the satisfaction of the registering
6 authority of the institution at which a student is registering, it shall be
7 presumed that:

8 (c) (I) (C) A member of the armed forces may apply for in-state
9 tuition classification for any of his or her dependents, including but not
10 limited to a spouse, upon meeting the requirements of this section. After
11 qualifying as an in-state student and while continuously enrolled as an
12 undergraduate or graduate student at an institution of higher education in
13 Colorado, ~~a dependent of a member of the armed forces of the United~~
14 ~~States on active duty, OR THE MEMBER'S SPOUSE OR DEPENDENT,~~ shall not
15 ~~lose the dependent's HIS OR HER ELIGIBILITY FOR in-state tuition status if~~
16 ~~the member is transferred outside of Colorado OR IF THE MEMBER RETIRES~~
17 ~~OR SEPARATES FROM THE MILITARY AND REMAINS IN COLORADO.~~ A
18 person who is a dependent of a member of the armed forces of the United
19 States who was on active duty in Colorado during the person's last year
20 of high school, and who attends a public institution of higher education
21 in Colorado within twelve months after graduating from a high school in
22 Colorado, shall be eligible for in-state tuition, AND THE ELIGIBILITY SHALL
23 NOT BE AFFECTED IF THE MEMBER IS TRANSFERRED OUTSIDE OF COLORADO



- 1 OR IF THE MEMBER RETIRES OR SEPARATES FROM THE MILITARY AND
- 2 REMAINS IN COLORADO; except that such a person is not eligible for
- 3 in-state tuition under this provision if the person has attended an
- 4 institution of higher education outside of Colorado."

- 5 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.
