Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not necessarily reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted.)

Interim Committee to Study School Finance. Under current law, charter schools that are created on or after July 1, 2004, that are in a school district (district) that has retained exclusive chartering authority, and that are in a district that serves an at-risk population greater than 40% of the total student population receive at-risk funding based on the at-risk population served by the charter school. Charter schools that do not fall into this category receive at-risk funding based on the at-risk population
