- 21 (a) IF RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY, NO ONE IS LIVING IN IT, AND IF 22 COMMERCIAL PROPERTY, NO LAWFUL BUSINESS IS BEING CONDUCTED 23 THERE; AND
- 24 (b) There is on the property an accumulation of weeds, 25 Brush, trash, and debris.
