## HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE REPORT

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:
HB09-1018 be amended as follows:
Amend printed bill, page 4, strike lines 9 through 27.
Page 5, strike lines 1 through 19 and substitute the following:
"SECTION 4. 1-2-305 (1) and (2), Colorado Revised Statutes, are amended to read:
1-2-305. Postelection procedures - voting history. (1) Not later than sixty days after a state election, each county clerk and recorder shall transmit to the secretary of state, in a media format acceptable to the secretary of state, THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL GENERATE a list of electors showing who voted and who did not vote in the election. The list shall contain the information provided for in section 1-2-301 (1) BEDRAWN FROM THE STATEWIDE VOTER REGISTRATION DATABASE. For electors who voted, the list shall show such elector's method of voting whether by early voting, mail-in ballot, mail ballot, polling place voting or otherwise.
(2) Upon receipt of the lists, the secretary of state shall EXAMINE THE LISTS TO SEE WHICH ELECTORS DID AND DID NOT VOTE IN THE ELECTION compare them with the master list of registered electors maintained in the office in order to ascertain if any elector has voted more than once. If it is determined that an elector has voted more than once the secretary of state shall notify the proper district attorney for prosecution of a violation of the provisions of this code.



SECTION 5. 1-2-603 (1), Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

- 3 1-2-603. Notification that elector has moved and registered in 4 different county. (1) If the elector registers to vote in another county, 5 the county clerk and recorder shall immediately transmit the information 6 to the county clerk and recorder of the elector's prior county of residence. Upon receipt of the information, the county clerk and recorder of the 7 8 county of prior residence shall cancel the elector's registration record. 9 The county clerk and recorder of the county of prior residence shall cancel the registration record only if the name and birth date or the name 10 11 and social security number of the elector match. OF THE ELECTOR'S NEW 12 COUNTY OF RESIDENCE SHALL TRANSFER THE ELECTOR'S REGISTRATION 13 RECORD FROM THE OLD COUNTY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FOLLOWING 14 REQUIREMENTS:
- 15 (a) If the elector provides a name, date of birth, and prior
  16 Address and the county clerk and recorder can match the name,
  17 Date of birth, and prior address to the elector's prior
  18 REGISTRATION RECORD, THE ELECTOR'S REGISTRATION RECORD SHALL BE
  19 TRANSFERRED FROM THE OLD COUNTY.
- 20 (b) If the elector provides a name and date of birth but 21 does not provide a prior address, the elector's registration 22 record shall be transferred from the old county only if:
- 23 (I) THE ELECTOR PROVIDES A DRIVER'S LICENSE OR
  24 IDENTIFICATION CARD NUMBER, AND THE COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER
  25 OF THE COUNTY CAN MATCH THE NAME, DATE OF BIRTH, AND DRIVER'S
  26 LICENSE OR IDENTIFICATION CARD NUMBER TO THE ELECTOR'S PRIOR
  27 REGISTRATION RECORD; OR
- 28 (II) THE ELECTOR PROVIDES A SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER, AND THE
  29 COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER OF THE COUNTY CAN MATCH THE NAME,
  30 DATE OF BIRTH, AND SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER TO THE ELECTOR'S PRIOR
  31 REGISTRATION RECORD.
- 32 (c) If the elector does not provide a prior address, 33 Driver's license number, or social security number, the 34 REGISTRATION RECORD SHALL NOT BE TRANSFERRED FROM THE OLD 35 COUNTY UNLESS THE ELECTOR SUBMITS ADDITIONAL INFORMATION THAT

- 4 ADDRESS OF RECORD. ANY SUCH NOTICE SHALL HAVE A RETURNABLE
- 5 PORTION THAT HAS THE RETURN POSTAGE PREPAID AND IS PREADDRESSED
- 6 TO THE SENDING COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER, AND SHALL INCLUDE AN
- AREA FOR THE ELECTOR TO INDICATE IF THE ELECTOR HAS MOVED TO
- 8 ANOTHER COUNTY AND WISHES TO HAVE HIS OR HER REGISTRATION
- 9 RECORD TRANSFERRED FROM THE OLD COUNTY.
- SECTION 6. 1-2-604 (1) and (2), Colorado Revised Statutes, are amended to read:
- 12 1-2-604. Cancellation of electors with a multiple registration.
- 13 (1) If the secretary of state's master list of registered electors shows an
- elector to be registered in more than one precinct in this state, the secretary of state shall notify every applicable county clerk and recorder
- 16 each month of such multiple registration. Each county clerk and recorder
- who receives such notification Based upon an examination of the
- 18 SECRETARY OF STATE'S MASTER LISTS OF REGISTERED ELECTORS, EACH
- 19 COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER SHALL GENERATE A LIST CONTAINING THE
- 20 NAME OF EACH ELECTOR WHO IS REGISTERED IN MORE THAN ONE PRECINCT
- 21 IN THE STATE AND shall cancel from the county's master lists of registered
- 22 electors the name of the elector wherever it appears, except where it
- 23 corresponds to the elector's most recent date of registration.
- 24 (2) Not later than fifteen days prior to each primary, general,";

4 (b) IF THE COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER IS NOT ABLE TO CANCEL 5 THE REGISTRATION RECORD PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPH (a) OF THIS 6 SUBSECTION (3), THE COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER SHALL SEND A 7 NOTICE TO THE ELECTOR WHOSE RECORD THE CLERK AND RECORDER 8 INTENDS TO CANCEL. THE NOTICE SHALL BE SENT TO THAT ELECTOR'S 9 ADDRESS OF RECORD, SHALL HAVE A RETURNABLE PORTION THAT HAS THE 10 RETURN POSTAGE PREPAID AND THAT IS PREADDRESSED TO THE SENDING 11 COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER, AND SHALL INCLUDE AN AREA FOR THE 12 ELECTOR TO INDICATE IF THE ELECTOR HAS MOVED TO ANOTHER COUNTY 13 AND WISHES TO HAVE HIS OR HER REGISTRATION RECORD TRANSFERRED 14 FROM THE OLD COUNTY.".
