

## CHRONIC CARE COLLABORATIVE'S SIX PRIORITY ISSUES:

- 1. Long term care based upon a foundation of integrated home and community based services
- 2. Mental health and services to person who have chronic disease
- 3. Integration of Medicare and Medicaid to maximize services and benefits
- 4. Eliminate exclusions in insurance policies related to pre-existing conditions or genetic screens
- 5. Clinical trials continuing private and public health insurance benefits for insured who participate in clinical trials
- 6. Prevention and wellness to continue life enhancing opportunities.

## A SEAT AT THE TABLE:

Administrative policy makers seeking expertise

- Board of Health Advisory Committee (Department of Health and Environment) a governor appointed consumer seat to develop the rules and regulations for personal care homes and related organizations.
- Long Term Care Advisory Committee (Department of Health Care Policy and Financing) a committee member to develop recommendations for programs and program modifications that will help create a coordinated continuum of long-term care services and a unified LTC delivery system.
- Silverprint Long Term Care Committee (follow-up to the 2005 White House Conference on Aging) a committee member which is charged to develop the section on the website and a strategic plan for long term care for Colorado.
- Center for Improving Value in Health Care (CIVHC) appointment by the Governor as a member of the Consumer Engagement Subcommittee to advise State on public insurance strategies; leverage commitment from public and private sector; integrate the work of other public and private entities in the state related to health care.
