<u>HB09-1160</u> be amended as follows:
Amend printed bill, strike everything below the enacting clause and substitute the following:
"SECTION 1. Part 2 of article 2 of title 1, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION to read:
1-2-202.5. Online voter registration - online changes in elector
information. (1) (a) AN ELECTOR MAY REGISTER TO VOTE, AND A
REGISTERED ELECTOR MAY CHANGE HIS OR HER RESIDENCE ON THE
REGISTRATION RECORD, CHANGE OR WITHDRAW HIS OR HER AFFILIATION,
APPLY FOR PERMANENT MAIL-IN BALLOT STATUS, OR AMEND HIS OR HER
EXISTING MAIL-IN BALLOT STATUS, BY COMPLETING AN ELECTRONIC FORM ON THE OFFICIAL WEB SITE OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE IF THE ELECTOR'S
SIGNATURE IS STORED IN DIGITAL FORM IN THE DATABASE SYSTEMS
MAINTAINED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE PURSUANT TO SECTION
1-2-301 (1) OR ACCESSIBLE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE IN
ACCORDANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTIONS 1-2-302 (6) AND
42-1-211 (1.5), C.R.S.
(b) THE OFFICIAL WEB SITE REFERENCED IN PARAGRAPH (a) OF THIS

(2) NO LATER THAN APRIL 1, 2010, THE SECRETARY OF STATE 1 2 SHALL MAKE AVAILABLE ON THE SECRETARY OF STATE'S OFFICIAL WEB 3 SITE ELECTRONIC FORMS FOR PERSONS TO APPLY TO REGISTER TO VOTE 4 AND FOR REGISTERED ELECTORS TO CHANGE HIS OR HER RESIDENCE, 5 CHANGE OR WITHDRAW HIS OR HER AFFILIATION, APPLY FOR PERMANENT 6 MAIL-IN BALLOT STATUS, OR AMEND HIS OR HER EXISTING MAIL-IN BALLOT 7 STATUS. 8 (3) THE ELECTRONIC VOTER REGISTRATION FORM SHALL INCLUDE: 9 (a) (I) THE QUESTIONS "ARE YOU A CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA?", "WILL YOU BE AT LEAST EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE 10 11 ON ELECTION DAY?", AND "HAVE YOU RESIDED IN COLORADO AND IN THE 12 PRECINCT IN WHICH YOU INTEND TO REGISTER FOR AT LEAST THIRTY DAYS 13 IMMEDIATELY PRIOR TO THE ELECTION?" AND PLACES FOR THE ELECTOR 14 TO INPUT ANSWERS TO THE QUESTIONS. (II) FOLLOWING THE QUESTIONS LISTED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF 15 16 THIS PARAGRAPH (a), THE FORM SHALL INCLUDE THE STATEMENT "IF YOU 17 CHECKED 'NO' IN RESPONSE TO ANY OF THESE QUESTIONS, DO NOT COMPLETE THIS APPLICATION BECAUSE YOU DO NOT QUALIFY AS AN 18 19 ELIGIBLE ELECTOR IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 1-2-101." 20 (b) THE QUESTIONS SPECIFIED IN SECTION 1-2-204 (1) AND (2) 21 WITH PLACES FOR THE ELECTOR TO INPUT INFORMATION IN RESPONSE TO 22 THE QUESTIONS; 23 A PLACE FOR THE ELECTOR TO INPUT ADDITIONAL 24 INFORMATION, AS DETERMINED BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE, NECESSARY 25 TO LOCATE THE ELECTOR'S SIGNATURE IN THE DATABASE SYSTEMS 26 SPECIFIED IN SUBSECTION (1) OF THIS SECTION AND A PLACE FOR THE 27 ELECTOR TO ASSENT TO THE USE OF THE SIGNATURE FOR VOTER 28 REGISTRATION PURPOSES; 29 (d) A SELF-AFFIRMATION THAT THE ELECTOR IS QUALIFIED TO 30 REGISTER AND THAT THE INFORMATION ENTERED BY THE ELECTOR ON THE 31 ELECTRONIC APPLICATION IS TRUE; AND 32

- 2 (4) (a) THE ELECTRONIC FORM FOR A REGISTERED ELECTOR TO CHANGE HIS OR HER RESIDENCE SHALL INCLUDE THE INFORMATION REQUIRED BY SECTION 1-2-216 (1).
- 5 (b) THE ELECTRONIC FORM FOR A REGISTERED ELECTOR TO CHANGE OR WITHDRAW HIS OR HER AFFILIATION SHALL INCLUDE THE INFORMATION REQUIRED BY SECTION 1-2-219 (1).
- 8 (c) The electronic form for a registered elector to apply 9 for permanent mail-in ballot status shall meet the 10 requirements of section 1-8-104.5 (1).
- 11 (5) AN ELECTOR'S ASSENT ON THE ELECTRONIC APPLICATION TO 12 THE USE OF HIS OR HER SIGNATURE FOR VOTER REGISTRATION PURPOSES 13 MEETS THE SIGNATURE REQUIREMENT OF SECTION 1-2-201 (2).
- 14 (6) THE COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER SHALL DETERMINE IF THE
 15 INFORMATION SUBMITTED ON THE ELECTRONIC FORM IS COMPLETE PRIOR

- 19 (7) (a) When a person completes an electronic voter 20 REGISTRATION FORM IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (3) OF THIS 21 SECTION AND IS QUALIFIED TO REGISTER BASED ON THE INFORMATION 22 PROVIDED IN THE FORM, THE COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER SHALL 23 SEARCH FOR THE ELECTOR'S SIGNATURE IN THE DATABASE SYSTEMS 24 SPECIFIED IN SUBSECTION (1) OF THIS SECTION. IF THE SIGNATURE IS 25 FOUND, THE COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER SHALL APPROVE THE NEW 26 REGISTRATION PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (6) OF THIS SECTION AND SHALL 27 ADD THE ELECTOR TO THE COMPUTERIZED STATEWIDE VOTER 28 REGISTRATION LIST MAINTAINED BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE PURSUANT 29 TO SECTION 1-2-301(1).
- 30 (b) When a registered elector completes an electronic 31 form to change his or her residence, change or withdraw his or 32 her affiliation, or apply for permanent mail-in ballot status, the 33 secretary of state shall search for the registered elector's 34 signature in the database systems specified in subsection (1) of

- 7 (c) A VOTER REGISTRATION, CHANGE OF RESIDENCE, CHANGE OR 8 WITHDRAWAL OF AFFILIATION, OR APPLICATION FOR PERMANENT MAIL-IN 9 BALLOT STATUS MADE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION SHALL APPLY 10 AN ELECTION IF THE ELECTOR COMPLETES THE ELECTRONIC FORM NO LATER THAN TWENTY-NINE DAYS BEFORE THE ELECTION.
- SECTION 2. 42-1-211 (1.5) (a), Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended to read:
- 14 42-1-211. Colorado state titling and registration system. (1.5) (a) In accordance with the requirements of section 1-2-302 (6.7) 15 SECTION 1-2-302 (6), C.R.S., the department of revenue and the 16 department of state shall allow for the exchange of information on 17 18 residence addresses, signatures, and party affiliation between the systems used by the department of revenue, the master list of registered electors 19 maintained by the department of state, and, no later than January 1, 2006, 20 the computerized statewide voter registration list created in section 21 1-2-301 (1), C.R.S., for the purpose of updating information in these 22 23 systems.
 - SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety."
