Interim Committee to Study Issues Related to Pinnacol Assurance

SHORT TITLE: "Workers' Compensation Accountability"

A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING ACCOUNTABILITY FOR WORKERS' COMPENSATION 102 INSURERS.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not necessarily reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted.)

Interim Committee to Study Issues Related to Pinnacol Assurance. Requires workers' compensation insurers to survey injured workers at the close of each claim. Requires the insurers to report the result of the surveys to the division of workers' compensation (division) in the department of labor and employment. Requires the division to post the survey results on the division's web site.

Requires the chief executive officer of Pinnacol Assurance to submit an annual report to the governor and committees of the general assembly reporting on the business operations, resources, and liabilities of the Pinnacol Assurance fund.

Requires the division to post on the division's web site the procedure for an injured worker to follow to file a complaint with the division regarding any issue over which the director or his or her designee has authority to pursue, settle, or enforce.

6	A CLAIM, EACH INSURER SHALL SURVEY THE CLAIMANT REGARDING THE
7	CLAIMANT'S SATISFACTION WITH THE INSURER. THE SURVEY SHALL BE
8	CONDUCTED IN A FORM AND MANNER AS PRESCRIBED BY THE DIRECTOR.
9	THE SURVEY SHALL INCLUDE QUESTIONS REGARDING COURTESY,
10	PROMPTNESS OF MEDICAL CARE, PROMPTNESS OF HANDLING THE CLAIM,
11	PROMPTNESS OF RESOLVING THE CLAIM, AND OVERALL SATISFACTION
12	WITH THE EXPERIENCE WITH THE INSURER.
13	(2) THE INSURER SHALL REPORT THE SURVEY RESULTS ANNUALLY
14	TO THE DIVISION. THE DIRECTOR SHALL POST THE RESULTS OF THE
