I am the Director of Facilities for Eagle County School District and a Board Director for the Colorado School Plant Managers Association. I have 31 years of Maintenance and Construction experience.

Eagle County Schools oppose this bill because of the added time and complexity that will be added to construction and renovation projects, as well as added complexity for routine maintenance-level projects.

Please note:

- *In our small district of seventeen schools, our district would be required to work with six different entities.
- *We would be required to create six MOUs with these entities, not all of whom have resources to adequately handle the needs in a timely manner.
- * This would add another level of costs to school operational and construction budgets.
- * We anticipate there is potential for conflict between local requirements and "school law".
