- 11 (II) IF, AT ANY TIME, THE DEPARTMENT DETERMINES THAT ONE OR 12 MORE OF THE CONDITIONS SPECIFIED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS 13 PARAGRAPH (e) ARE NO LONGER MET, THE DEPARTMENT MAY BRING THE 14 RELEVANT INFORMATION TO THE SOLID AND HAZARDOUS WASTE 15 COMMISSION WITH A RECOMMENDATION TO RESCIND THE WAIVER OF THE 16 REQUIREMENT TO INSTALL FABRICATED LINERS. IF THE SOLID AND 17 HAZARDOUS WASTE COMMISSION DETERMINES THAT ONE OR MORE OF THE 18 CONDITIONS ARE NO LONGER BEING MET, THE SOLID AND HAZARDOUS 19 WASTE COMMISSION MAY RESCIND THE WAIVER AND INSTRUCT THE 20 DEPARTMENT TO ESTABLISH A COMPLIANCE SCHEDULE FOR THE OWNER OR 21 OPERATOR TO INSTALL FABRICATED LINERS.".
