After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB09-1180 be amended as follows:

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 3, after line 20, insert the following:

2 "SECTION 4. 18-12-211 (2), Colorado Revised Statutes, is
3 amended to read:

4 **18-12-211. Renewal of permits.** (2) (a) A permittee who fails
5 to file a renewal form on or before the permit expiration date may renew
6 the permit by paying a late fee of fifteen dollars in addition to the renewal
7 fee established pursuant to subsection (1) of this section. No permit shall
8 be renewed six months or more after its expiration date, and the permit
9 shall be deemed to have permanently expired. A person whose permit has
10 permanently expired may reapply for a permit, but the person shall submit
11 an application for a permit and the fee required pursuant to section
12 18-12-205. A person who knowingly and intentionally files false or
13 misleading information or deliberately omits material information
14 required under this section is subject to criminal prosecution for perjury
15 under section 18-8-503.

16 (b) IF A PERMITTEE FAILS TO FILE A RENEWAL FORM ON OR BEFORE
17 THE PERMIT EXPIRATION DATE, HIS OR HER PERMIT SHALL BE INVALID
18 FROM THE PERMIT EXPIRATION DATE UNTIL SUCH TIME AS THE PERMIT IS
19 RENEWED BY THE SHERIFF WHO ISSUED THE PERMIT."
