13 14 15 16 17 18 19	(1.5) A TRANSFEREE WHO HOLDS A VALID PERMIT TO CARRY A CONCEALED HANDGUN, WHICH PERMIT WAS ISSUED OR RENEWED PURSUANT TO SECTION 18-12-203, C.R.S., ON OR AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SUBSECTION (1.5), IS EXEMPT FROM THE BACKGROUND CHECK REQUIREMENT DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1) OF THIS SECTION IF HE OR SHE PRESENTS THE PERMIT TO A GUN SHOW VENDOR TRANSFEROR AT THE TIME OF THE TRANSFER OR ATTEMPTED TRANSFER OF A FIREARM.
