What is The TRIO Mission?

To encourage and assist people who are traditionally under represented in postsecondary education because of income, family educational background, disability, or other relevant federal, state, provincial or institutional criteria, in the preparation for, entry to, and completion of a post-secondary education.





What is TRiO?

- Funded under the Higher Ed. Act of 1965
- · Initially just three programs...thus TRiO
- 1. Upward Bound......College Prep.
- 2. Talent Search......College Prep.
- 3. Student Support Services..College Suppt.

- 6. Veterans Upward Bound... Veteran Support
- 7. Ronald E. McNair Achievement Program... doctorial studies
- 8. Training Programs for TRiO Staff

TRiO at LCC..Student Support Services (SSS)

- Five year competitive grant cycle starting in 2010-2011 with 160 students served in an academic year
- Two-thirds (107) students must be lowincome, first generation, or disabled

TRIO at LCC..Student Support Services (SSS)

- The final 53 students can be either first generation, low income, or disabled
- All students must demonstrate academic need (ACT, accuplacer, instructor recommendation)
