All public and private grants, gifts, and donations received by the department pursuant to this section shall be transmitted to the state treasurer who shall credit the same, in addition to any appropriations made by the general assembly AND THE MONEYS TRANSFERRED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (2) OF THIS SECTION, to the school awards program fund, which is hereby created in the state treasury.
- 31 (b) Moneys in the school awards program fund shall be subject to 32 appropriation by the general assembly to the department of education for 33 purposes of making financial awards pursuant to the provisions of this 34 part 3. At the end of any fiscal year, all unexpended and unencumbered 35 moneys in the school awards program fund shall remain therein and shall
