## Gentlemen:

Last week, the Solicitor General signed the rule opinion regarding the recently enacted Rules of the Oil and Gas Commission. That opinion is based purely on an analysis of the facial constitutionality and legality of the rules. I want to assure you that Mr. Domenico's signature on these rules does not indicate our agreement with all of the public policy behind them. In fact, I believe there are aspects of these rules that are problematic from a public policy perspective, including the potential for unreasonable delays in the permitting process.

Accordingly, I urge the legislature to carefully consider these rules in this upcoming legislative session.
