Amendments/Appropriation Status

The bill neither requires nor contains an appropriation clause for FY 2009-10. The Department of Revenue does not require appropriations of \$27,275 from the Motorist Insurance Identification Account, \$15,452 from the Colorado State Titling and Registration Account, or \$3,708 from the Auto Dealers License Fund for computer programming costs as identified in the Legislative Council Staff Revised Fiscal Note dated April 14, 2009, because the Long Bill includes an appropriation for the Department of Revenue to implement legislation that requires computer programming hours. Programming costs in the Department of Revenue will be shown in the Long Bill line item titled "Programming Costs for 2009 Session Legislation.
