TITLE: CONCERNING THE ELECTION OF A DIRECTOR OF A WATER CONSERVANCY DISTRICT.

Summary of Legislation

This bill modifies the number of registered voters that must sign a petition to elect a director of a water conservancy district in lieu of the court appointing a director. It also eliminates the requirement that an elected director own real property within the district.

The bill was postponed indefinitely by the House Agriculture, Livestock and Natural Resources Committee on January 28, 2009.

Assessment

The bill is assessed at having no fiscal impact. It is not expected to significantly affect the number of elections held for water conservancy district director positions and will not otherwise affect state or local government revenue or expenditures.
