Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB14-129 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 18, after line 20, insert:

2 "SECTION 13. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-43.3-501, add
3 (1) (b) (I.5) as follows:

4 **12-43.3-501. Marijuana cash fund - repeal.** (1) (b) Moneys in
5 the fund shall be subject to annual appropriation by the general assembly
6 to:

7 (I.5) (A) THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE FOR UPDATES TO THE
8 DEPARTMENT'S DRIVER'S LICENSE SYSTEM TO GENERATE REVOCATION
9 LETTERS CONNECTED TO A CONVICTION OF UNDERAGE POSSESSION OR
10 CONSUMPTION OF MARIJUANA.

11 (B) THIS SUBPARAGRAPH (I.5) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE JULY 1,
12 2015.

13 **SECTION 14. Appropriation.** (1) In addition to any other
14 appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the
15 marijuana cash fund created in section 12-43.3-501 (1) (a), Colorado
16 Revised Statutes, not otherwise appropriated, to the department of
17 revenue, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013, the sum of \$4,120, or
18 so much thereof as may be necessary, for the purchase of computer center
19 services related to the implementation of this act.

20 (2) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby
21 appropriated to the governor - lieutenant governor - state planning and
22 budgeting, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013, the sum of \$4,120,
23 or so much thereof as may be necessary, for allocation to the office of

1 information technology, for the provision of computer center services for
2 the department of revenue related to the implementation of this act. Said
3 sum is from reappropriated funds received from the department of
4 revenue out of the appropriation made in subsection (1) of this section.

5 **SECTION 15. Appropriation.** (1) In addition to any other
6 appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the
7 adolescent substance abuse prevention and treatment fund created in
8 section 18-13-122 (18), Colorado Revised Statutes, not otherwise
9 appropriated, to the department of human services, for the fiscal year
10 beginning July 1, 2014, the sum of \$38,250, to be allocated to behavioral
11 health services for adolescent substance abuse prevention and treatment
12 programs as follows:

- 13 (a) \$28,687 for treatment and detoxification contracts; and
- 14 (b) \$9,563 for prevention contracts."

15 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

16 Page 18, strike lines 22 and 23 and substitute "effect upon passage, and
17 applies to offenses committed on or after July 1, 2014."

18 Page 1, line 102, strike "MARIJUANA." and substitute "MARIJUANA, AND,
19 IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION."
