**TITLE:** CONCERNING CLARIFICATION OF RESIDENCY STATUS FOR THE PURPOSE OF GRANTING RECIPROCITY TO CONCEALED WEAPONS PERMITS ISSUED BY STATES OTHER THAN COLORADO.

**Summary of Assessment**

This bill, *as amended by the Senate Judiciary Committee*, clarifies that a person may use a permit to carry a concealed handgun issued in another state if that person is currently a resident of the issuing state, or has lived in Colorado for no more than 90 days. The bill will become effective upon signature of the Governor.

Although this bill may slightly increase the number of people charged with carrying a concealed weapon without an appropriate permit (a misdemeanor 2 penalty per Section 18-12-105, C.R.S.), it is anticipated that the number of cases for the Judicial Branch will be small enough to be absorbable within existing resources. Thus, the bill does not affect state or local revenue or expenditures and is assessed as having no fiscal impact.
