Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB07-1301 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend Health and Human Services Committee Report, dated March 8,
- 2 2007, page 1, strike lines 1 through 20.

- 3 Page 2, strike lines 1 through 10 and substitute the following:

- 4 "Amend printed bill, page 2, line 4, strike "23" and substitute "24";".

- 5 Page 3 of the committee report, strike lines 4 and 5 and substitute the
- 6 following

- 7 "strike lines 4 through 11.

- 8 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.";

- 9 line 6, before "line", insert "Page 6,";

- 10 after line 8, insert the following:

- 11 "Page 8, after line 5, insert the following:

- 12 **"SECTION 5. Appropriation.** (1) For the implementation of
- 13 this act, appropriations made to the department of public health and
- 14 environment, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, shall be adjusted
- 15 as follows:

1 (a) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby
2 appropriated, to the disease control and environmental epidemiology
3 division, for allocation to the cervical cancer immunization program to
4 immunize female minors and women in Colorado against cervical cancer
5 as created in section 25-4-2303, Colorado Revised Statutes, of this act,
6 the sum of forty-two thousand six hundred dollars (\$42,600), cash funds
7 exempt, or so much thereof as may be necessary. This appropriation shall
8 be from the Colorado immunization fund created in section 25-4-2301,
9 Colorado Revised Statutes.

10 (b) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby
11 appropriated, to the disease control and environmental epidemiology
12 division, for allocation to the public awareness campaign on cervical
13 cancer immunization and the benefits of receiving cervical cancer
14 immunization pursuant to section 25-4-2305 (1), Colorado Revised
15 Statutes, of this act, the sum of two hundred twenty-five thousand dollars
16 (\$225,000), cash funds exempt, or so much thereof as may be necessary.
17 This appropriation shall be from any gifts, grants, and donations received
18 by the department for this purpose and deposited into the cervical cancer
19 immunization awareness campaign fund created in section 25-4-2305 (2),
20 Colorado Revised Statutes.

21 (2) For the implementation of this act, appropriations made to the
22 department of health care policy and financing, for the fiscal year
23 beginning July 1, 2007, to the indigent care program, for allocation to the
24 children's basic health plan premiums costs, the sum of two hundred
25 ninety-eight thousand one hundred seventy-seven dollars (\$298,177). Of
26 said sum, ninety thousand seven hundred ninety-five dollars (\$90,795)
27 shall be cash funds exempt from the Colorado immunization fund created
28 in section 25-4-2301, Colorado Revised Statutes, thirteen thousand five
29 hundred sixty-seven dollars (\$13,567) shall be cash funds exempt from
30 the health care expansion fund created in section 24-22-117 (2) (a) (I),
31 Colorado Revised Statutes, and one hundred ninety-three thousand eight
32 hundred fifteen dollars (\$193,815) shall be from federal funds.

33 **SECTION 6.** Section 14 (5) (b) of Senate Bill 07-097, enacted at
34 the First Regular Session of the Sixty-sixth General Assembly, is
35 amended to read:

36 Section 14. **Appropriation** (5) (b) In addition to any other



1 appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the
2 supplemental tobacco litigation settlement moneys account within the
3 Colorado immunization fund created in ~~section 25-4-2305~~, SECTION 25-4-
4 2301, Colorado Revised Statutes, not otherwise appropriated, to the
5 department of public health and environment, disease control and
6 environmental epidemiology division, for the fiscal year beginning July
7 1, 2007, the sum of ~~nine hundred thousand dollars (\$900,000)~~, FIVE
8 HUNDRED SIXTY-SIX THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FIVE DOLLARS (\$566,605),
9 cash funds exempt, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the
10 implementation of this act.

11 **SECTION 7. Appropriation.** (1) In addition to any other
12 appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the
13 supplemental tobacco litigation settlement moneys account within the
14 Colorado immunization fund created in section 25-4-2301, Colorado
15 Revised Statutes, not otherwise appropriated, to the department of public
16 health and environment, disease control and environmental epidemiology
17 division, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, the sum of two
18 hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000), cash funds exempt, or so much
19 thereof as may be necessary, for the implementation of this act.

20 **SECTION 8. Effective date.** (1) Except as otherwise provided
21 in subsection (2) of this section, this act shall take effect upon passage.

22 (2) Section 7 of this act shall take effect January 1, 2008, only if
23 the executive director of the department of public health and environment
24 does not certify to the revisor of statutes that eight hundred thousand
25 dollars or more has been received in gifts, grants, or donations, in the
26 cervical cancer immunization awareness campaign fund."
