**TITLE:** CONCERNING THE ELIMINATION OF THE REQUIREMENTS FOR A VOTE RATIFYING AN ALL-UNION AGREEMENT.**Summary of Assessment**

This bill repeals the requirement that employees in a workplace with a union must vote to ratify an all-union agreement. Under current law, a majority of members or three-quarters of those voting must vote in favor of the agreement. The bill was vetoed by the Governor on February 9, 2007.

Only about 6 to 8 all-union elections are conducted annually. While the Division of Labor, Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) has staff who administer all-union agreements, this is only a small portion of their duties. Therefore, the reduction in workload will be minimal and will not decrease DOLE personnel. As such, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.
