**TITLE:** CONCERNING A REPEAL OF THE PROHIBITION AGAINST A STATEWIDE DATABASE FOR PERSONS HOLDING PERMITS TO CARRY CONCEALED HANDGUNS.

**Summary of Assessment**

This reengrossed bill repeals the July 1, 2007, sunset date on the statewide database of permits for carrying a concealed handgun. The bill also prohibits a peace officer from using or searching such a database to establish reasonable suspicion for a traffic stop, to justify probable cause, or for search and seizure of a person's vehicle or property without additional information. The bill will become effective upon signature of the Governor.

Because this bill extends indefinitely the ability to maintain an existing statewide database of permittees, it does not impact the current practices of any state or local agency. Thus, this bill will not affect state or local revenues or expenditures and is assessed as having no fiscal impact.
