At the request of Representative McCann, members of the Colorado Trial Lawyers Association (CTLA) worked with the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing to craft HB09-1191 which changes CRS 25.5-4-301(5)(a). Together, representatives from both organizations agreed on language to assure Colorado collection/subrogation provisions are in line with federal requirements not only currently but in the event of changes in federal law applicable to Colorado.
