




## Fiscal Year 2012-13= \$20.5 Billion

## Fiscal Year 2012-13= \$7.6 Billion



 Adds \$294,000 cash funds to true-up approps. for Purses and Breeders Awards

 Reduces GF by \$1.6 mil to adjust for March forecast for Cigarette Tax Rebate and Old Age Heat and Fuel and Property Tax Assistance Grants

 Reduces total funds by \$1.4 mil including increase of \$22 mil GF in part due to refinancing Licensing Services Cash Fund with GF
