HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Finance.HB12-1272 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 2, line 3, strike "(6) introductory portion," and
2 substitute "(6),".

3 Page 4, after line 22 insert:

4 (a) A demographic analysis of participants in the enhanced
5 unemployment insurance compensation benefits program under this
6 section, including ~~the number of claimants per North American industry~~
7 ~~classification system code and the gender, race, age, and geographic~~
8 representation of participants;

9 (b) The duration of the enhanced unemployment insurance
10 compensation benefits claimed per eligible unemployment insurance
11 claimant;

12 (c) ~~An analysis of the training provided to participants, including~~
13 ~~the occupational category supported by the training, those participants~~
14 ~~who completed training in relationship to those that do not complete~~
15 ~~training, and the reasons for noncompletion of approved training~~
16 programs;

17 (d) The employment and wage history of participants, including
18 the pre-training and post-training wage and whether those participating
19 in training return to their previous employer or occupation after training;

20 (e) ~~An identification and analysis of administrative costs at both~~
21 ~~the local and state level for administering the enhanced unemployment~~
22 ~~insurance compensation benefits program~~ A RETURN ON INVESTMENT
23 CALCULATION TO DETERMINE THE BENEFITS AND FISCAL CONTRIBUTION OF
24 UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE CLAIMANTS PARTICIPATING IN THE PROGRAM
25 WHO BECOME EMPLOYED. EMPLOYERS PARTICIPATING IN THE PROGRAM
26 SHALL PROVIDE THE DEPARTMENT INFORMATION ON PERMANENT HIRES OF
27 PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS, AS WELL AS FEEDBACK ON PROGRAM VALUE AND
28 ISSUES, FOR USE BY THE DEPARTMENT IN CALCULATING THE RETURN ON
29 INVESTMENT."

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
