Plates for Awareness

Awareness is the core of what we do. We believe strongly that making people aware of our services will increase the chance that people will find support when a child dies at any age. One goal of our License Plate Project is to increase awareness.

Plates for Healing

Families coping after the death of a child will cherish the opportunity to display a license plate that says they are remembering a child. This plate will be suitable for parents, friends, extended family, and siblings and serve as a small part of a healthy healing process after the death of a child.

No Fundraising

Rowan Tree Foundation will receive no funds from the sale of these plates.

A Purple Candle

Our trademarked design created expressly for our license plate will appeal to a wide audience. Purple is the color of healing, the candle is lit in memorial, and the white heart stands out as a message that love is forever. Below the image, the words **CHILD LOSS.ORG** will be a simple, easy to remember web address dedicated to the story of how our plate came to be, links to resources, and news about memorial events, and more.

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Memorial Events

We own the "Angel of Hope" memorial statue in Parker, CO at which we host two <u>FREE</u> memorial events annually. A Butterfly Release takes place each June, and a Candlelight Remembrance every December.

During our December Program, as each child's name is read aloud, the child's family places a long-stemmed white flower at the base of the statue. The event takes place in the evening, and the entire park is lit with hundreds of white luminaria that light the way to the statue in the winter night.

For our summer Butterfly Release, each person receives their own butterfly to open in honor of the child they are remembering. It is a powerful and moving event that always concludes with smiles and uplifted hearts and children chasing hundreds of huge monarch butterflies in the meadow behind the statue.



Remembering with Lovenotes

Our newest program, launched in 2011, our Lovenotes are handmade personalized cards that are sent to parents for the anniversary of their child's death. The message within is always a wish for peace and letting them know we are remembering their child with them.
