Subcommittees:

Medication, Health Care and Public Benefits Subcommittee:

This subcommittee meets monthly with members of the Task Force as well as other interested stake holders to study various issues surrounding these topics and how individuals with mental illness in the criminal justice system are effected.

Juvenile Subcommittee

This subcommittee meets approximately monthly to study issues related to juveniles with mental illness involved in the criminal justice system.

Housing Subcommittee

Currently, the Task Force is seeking a Chair for the subcommittee.

2012 Goals
