SUBJECT: Possible sources and types of written evidence relating to ethics

complaint¹

Under House Rule 49 (c), the preliminary investigation of the House Ethics Committee is required to consist of an examination of the complaint, the answer, if any, and any other evidence compiled pursuant to the request of the Committee.

The following list is provided merely to assist the Committee in identifying possible sources and types of written evidence that may be relevant to the Committee's preliminary investigation of the ethics complaint filed against Representative Laura Bradford and that the Committee may want to consider requesting.

Representative Laura Bradford	Any and all calendars, receipts, records, e-mails, recorded voice mail messages, citations, or other written documentation, regardless of form, showing or otherwise relating to the activities of Representative Bradford from 12:00 noon until 12:00 pm midnight on January 25, 2012, including but not limited to Representative Bradford's involvement in a traffic stop made by the Denver Police Department in the City and County of Denver.

Ms. Mary Dulacki Records Coordinator Office of the Manager of Safety City and County of Denver	A copy of any citation issued to Representative Laura Bradford by the Denver Police Department during a traffic stop in the City and County of Denver on January 25, 2012, a copy of Denver Police Department radio transmissions made as a result of this traffic stop, and any written statements or reports made by officers of the Denver Police Department who were on-scene during this traffic stop and that describe the events leading up to or occurring during this traffic stop.

News media (Possible sources: The Denver Post, Channel 9 News, Channel 7 News, Channel 4 News, Fox31 News) Any audio or audio/video recordings of statements made by any representative or officer of the Denver Police Department during the period of time between January 26, 2012, and February 1, 2012, regarding a traffic stop occurring on January 25, 2012, in the City and County of Denver during which the Denver Police Department issued a citation to Representative Laura Bradford.
