Economic Downturn 2009 legislative session. Legislature halted the scholarships and stipend payments. The Governor used state stimulus monies to fund stipends for 08-09 and 09-10. The allocation was \$1.4 million for stipends and \$200,000 for scholarships for the two cycles of 2009-2011.

\$100,000 in stimulus monies from the Governor 2009 - 2010

Stimulus monies didn't come until October so there wasn't enough time to recruit 100 candidates.

\$100,000 in stimulus monies from the Governor 2010-2011 2011 - 2012

\$138,000 in ARRA monies returned to CDE from district. CO escrow at NBPTS and the ARRA monies enabled \$2000 payment (CO \$750, Fed \$1,250)

A nonrefundable \$65 processing charge is required when you submit your application.
