Fiscal Assessment of Proposed Amendment HB1141 L.005.

This memorandum is an assessment of the fiscal impact of the attached proposed amendment to **HB12-1141**. This fiscal assessment is for the impact of the bill with inclusion of this amendment <u>only</u>. Any other added amendment could influence the fiscal impact.

# **Summary of Proposed Amendment**

Amendment L.005 is a strike-below amendment that expands the scope of practice for mental health professionals and nurses who have completed specific training to perform the Five-Point National Acupuncture Detoxification Association Auricular Acupuncture Protocol in conjunction with the treatment of an addiction disorder.

# **Fiscal Impact of Amendment**

This amendment reduces the fiscal impact of the bill to a minimal amount that can be addressed within existing appropriations.

#### Bill's Revised Fiscal Impact with Amendment

The fiscal impact of HB12-1141 with Amendment L.005 is minimal and can be addressed within existing appropriations.

# HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT Committee on Health and Environment.

#### HB12-1141 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, strike everything below the enacting clause and 2 substitute:

"SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-29.5-105, add (3) as follows:

12-29.5-105. Unlawful acts - exceptions. (3) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION OF THIS ARTICLE TO THE CONTRARY, A NURSE MAY PERFORM FIVE-POINT AURICULAR ACUDETOX PROTOCOL IN COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 12-38-111.3 AND A MENTAL HEALTH PROFESSIONAL MAY PERFORM FIVE-POINT AURICULAR ACUDETOX PROTOCOL IN COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 12-43-207.5.

**SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 12-38-111.3 as follows:

12-38-111.3. Five-point NADA auricular acudetox protocol nurses - definitions. (1) A PRACTICAL OR PROFESSIONAL NURSE LICENSED PURSUANT TO THIS PART 1 WHO HAS SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED THE NATIONAL ACUPUNCTURE DETOXIFICATION ASSOCIATION TRAINING OR EQUIVALENT TRAINING AS DETERMINED BY THE BOARD MAY PERFORM FIVE-POINT NADA AURICULAR ACUDETOX PROTOCOL ON A PATIENT WHO HAS BEEN DIAGNOSED WITH AN ADDICTION DISORDER BY A PERSON WHO IS LICENSED TO DIAGNOSE THE DISORDER AND WHEN USED EXCLUSIVELY AND SPECIFICALLY IN CONJUNCTION WITH TREATMENT OF AN ADDICTION DISORDER. THE PRACTICAL OR PROFESSIONAL NURSE SHALL PERFORM THE FIVE-POINT NADA AURICULAR ACUDETOX PROTOCOL ONLY UNDER THE DIRECT OR INDIRECT SUPERVISION OF AN ACUPUNCTURIST LICENSED IN THIS STATE WHO HAS COMPLETED THE FIVE-POINT AURICULAR ACUDETOX TRAINING OR A NADA-CERTIFIED PHYSICIAN LICENSED IN THIS STATE WHO HAS COMPLETED THE FIVE-POINT AURICULAR ACUDETOX TRAINING. THE PRACTICAL OR PROFESSIONAL NURSE SHALL PERFORM THE FIVE-POINT NADA AURICULAR ACUDETOX PROTOCOL IN A MANNER CONSISTENT WITH 30 GENERALLY ACCEPTED PARAMETERS, INCLUDING CLEAN NEEDLE TECHNIQUES AND STANDARDS OF THE CENTER FOR COMMUNICABLE 32 DISEASES, AND THAT MEETS SAFE AND PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS.

- (2) As used in this section:
- 34 (a) "FIVE-POINT NADA AURICULAR ACUDETOX PROTOCOL" MEANS 35 THE SUBCUTANEOUS INSERTION OF STERILE, DISPOSABLE ACUPUNCTURE 36 NEEDLES IN THE FOLLOWING FIVE CONSISTENT, PREDETERMINED 37 **BILATERAL LOCATIONS:**



(I) SYMPATHETIC;

(II) SHEN MEN;

(III) KIDNEY;

- (IV) LIVER; AND
- (V) Lung.
  - (b) "Indirect supervision" means supervision that does not require the presence of the supervisor in the office or on the premises at the time the procedure is being performed, but does require the practical or professional nurse to have an ongoing relationship with the supervisor and for the supervisor to be available for consultation and periodic direct observation of the procedure.
  - (c) "NADA" MEANS THE NATIONAL ACUPUNCTURE DETOXIFICATION ASSOCIATION.

**SECTION 3.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **add** 12-43-207.5 as follows:

12-43-207.5. Five-point auricular acudetox protocol - mental health professionals - definitions. (1) A PSYCHOLOGIST, SOCIAL WORKER, MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPIST, LICENSED PROFESSIONAL COUNSELOR, LICENSED ADDICTION COUNSELOR, OR LEVEL III CERTIFIED ADDICTION COUNSELOR, REFERRED TO COLLECTIVELY IN THIS SECTION AS "MENTAL HEALTH PROFESSIONALS", CERTIFIED OR LICENSED PURSUANT TO THIS ARTICLE WHO HAS SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED THE NATIONAL ACUPUNCTURE DETOXIFICATION ASSOCIATION TRAINING OR EQUIVALENT TRAINING AS DETERMINED BY THE DIRECTOR MAY PERFORM FIVE-POINT AURICULAR ACUDETOX PROTOCOL ON A PATIENT WHO HAS BEEN DIAGNOSED WITH AN ADDICTION DISORDER BY A PERSON WHO IS LICENSED TO DIAGNOSE THE DISORDER AND WHEN USED EXCLUSIVELY AND SPECIFICALLY IN CONJUNCTION WITH TREATMENT OF AN ADDICTION DISORDER. A PSYCHOLOGIST, SOCIAL WORKER, MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPIST, LICENSED PROFESSIONAL COUNSELOR, LICENSED ADDICTION COUNSELOR, OR LEVEL III CERTIFIED ADDICTION COUNSELOR SHALL PERFORM THE FIVE-POINT AURICULAR ACUDETOX PROTOCOL ONLY UNDER THE DIRECT OR INDIRECT SUPERVISION OF AN ACUPUNCTURIST LICENSED IN THIS STATE WHO HAS COMPLETED THE FIVE-POINT AURICULAR ACUDETOX TRAINING OR A NADA-CERTIFIED PHYSICIAN LICENSED IN THIS STATE WHO HAS COMPLETED THE FIVE-POINT AURICULAR ACUDETOX TRAINING. THE MENTAL HEALTH PROFESSIONAL SHALL PERFORM THE FIVE-POINT AURICULAR ACUDETOX PROTOCOL IN A MANNER CONSISTENT WITH GENERALLY ACCEPTED PARAMETERS, INCLUDING CLEAN NEEDLE TECHNIQUES AND STANDARDS OF THE CENTER FOR COMMUNICABLE



- DISEASES, AND THAT MEETS SAFE AND PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS.
  - (2) As used in this section:
- (a) "FIVE-POINT AURICULAR ACUDETOX PROTOCOL" MEANS THE SUBCUTANEOUS INSERTION OF STERILE, DISPOSABLE ACUPUNCTURE NEEDLES IN THE FOLLOWING FIVE CONSISTENT, PREDETERMINED BILATERAL LOCATIONS:
  - (I) SYMPATHETIC;
- (II) SHEN MEN;
- (III) KIDNEY;
- 10 (IV) LIVER; AND
- 11 (V) LUNG.

- (b) "Indirect supervision" means supervision that does not require the presence of the supervisor in the office or on the premises at the time the procedure is being performed, but does require the mental health professional to have an ongoing relationship with the supervisor and for the supervisor to be available for consultation and periodic direct observation of the procedure.
- (c) "NADA" MEANS THE NATIONAL ACUPUNCTURE DETOXIFICATION ASSOCIATION.

**SECTION 4.** Effective date. This act takes effect July 1, 2012. **SECTION 5.** Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.".
