Sponsor amendment **L.004** is a technical amendment to change one reference to age 17 to age 18, to correct an omission in the Senate Education Committee report. **This amendment would not affect the fiscal impact of the bill.**

**Points to Consider**

Although this bill would not require a General Fund appropriation for FY 2006-07, it is projected to require General Fund appropriations of \$2,356,112 and 2.0 FTE in FY 2007-08 and \$3,753,237 and 4.0 FTE in FY 2008-09.
