

Banking Limits

Shall there be an amendment to the Colorado Constitution which limits any bank or savings institution or any bank controlled by a holding company not regulated or supervised by the state of Colorado Banking Commission to limit the size of these institutions to 5% of the total deposits originated within Colorado as determined upon the public reports most recently filed with the appropriate federal regulatory agency. State-chartered commercial banks, industrial banks, trust companies, and state-regulated money transmitters shall be exempt. State chartered or state supervised Credit Unions, Savings and Loans, and Savings Banks shall be exempt.
