**NO. 4: COLORADO CITIZENS' RIGHT TO ELECT COLORADO JUDGES**

**INITIATIVE:** In order to comply with the Constitution of the United States Of America, Article IV, Section IV and Article XIV, Section 2 (Open Elections Of Judicial Officers), and the Constitution Of The State Of Colorado, Article II, Bill of Rights, Section 5 (Freedom of Elections) and Article VI, Section 6 (Election of Judges): should Article VI, Section 6, which was repealed effective January 17, 1967, be reinstated, in its entirety, in order to again allow for the free and open election of all Colorado state, county and municipal court judges, by the voters of Colorado.
