

Public Vote to Transfer State Resources

Be it Enacted by the People of the State of Colorado:

Section 35 of article V of the constitution of the state of Colorado is amended to read:

Section 35. Delegation of power – no authority for the state of Colorado government to alienate designated public lands or associated mineral resources. (1) The general assembly shall not delegate to any special commission, private corporation or association, any power to make, supervise or interfere with any municipal OR STATE improvement, ~~money~~, property or effects, whether held in trust or otherwise, or to levy taxes or perform any municipal function whatever.

(2) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, NOR ANY AGENCY OF THE STATE OF COLORADO, NOR ANY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION, NOR ANY STATUTORILY-AUTHORIZED AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF COLORADO, SHALL ACT IN ANY MANNER THAT WOULD CAUSE, OR ENABLE, THE STATE OF COLORADO GOVERNMENT TO ALIENATE OR TRANSFER FROM THE PUBLIC DOMAIN AN INTEREST IN STATE PARKS LANDS OR THE MINERALS RESOURCES ASSOCIATED THERETO; OR AN INTEREST IN A STATE WILDLIFE AREA OR THE MINERAL RESOURCES ASSOCIATED THERETO; TO ANY PROPRIETARY SPECIAL COMMISSION, PRIVATE CORPORATION, PERSON OR ASSOCIATION, ANY RIGHTS OF PROPERTY WITHOUT A VOTE OF THE PUBLIC.

(3) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY SHALL NOT BE AUTHORIZED TO DELEGATE TO ANY STATE GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY OR QUASI-GOVERNMENT AUTHORITY IN COLORADO THE ABILITY TO ENTRUST TO ANY SPECIAL COMMISSION, PRIVATE CORPORATION, PERSON, OR ASSOCIATION, ANY POWER TO LEASE OR TO TRANSFER PROPERTY INTERESTS IN STATE PARKS LANDS, OR THE MINERALS RESOURCES ASSOCIATED THERETO; OR ANY STATE WILDLIFE AREAS, OR THE MINERAL RESOURCES ASSOCIATED THERETO; OR TO PERFORM ANY MUNICIPAL FUNCTION ASSOCIATED WITH ANY STATE PARKS LANDS OR THE MINERALS RESOURCES ASSOCIATED THERETO; OR ANY STATE WILDLIFE

AREAS OR THE MINERAL RESOURCES ASSOCIATED THERETO; ANY INTERESTS
THERETO WHATEVER WITHOUT A VOTE OF THE PUBLIC.
