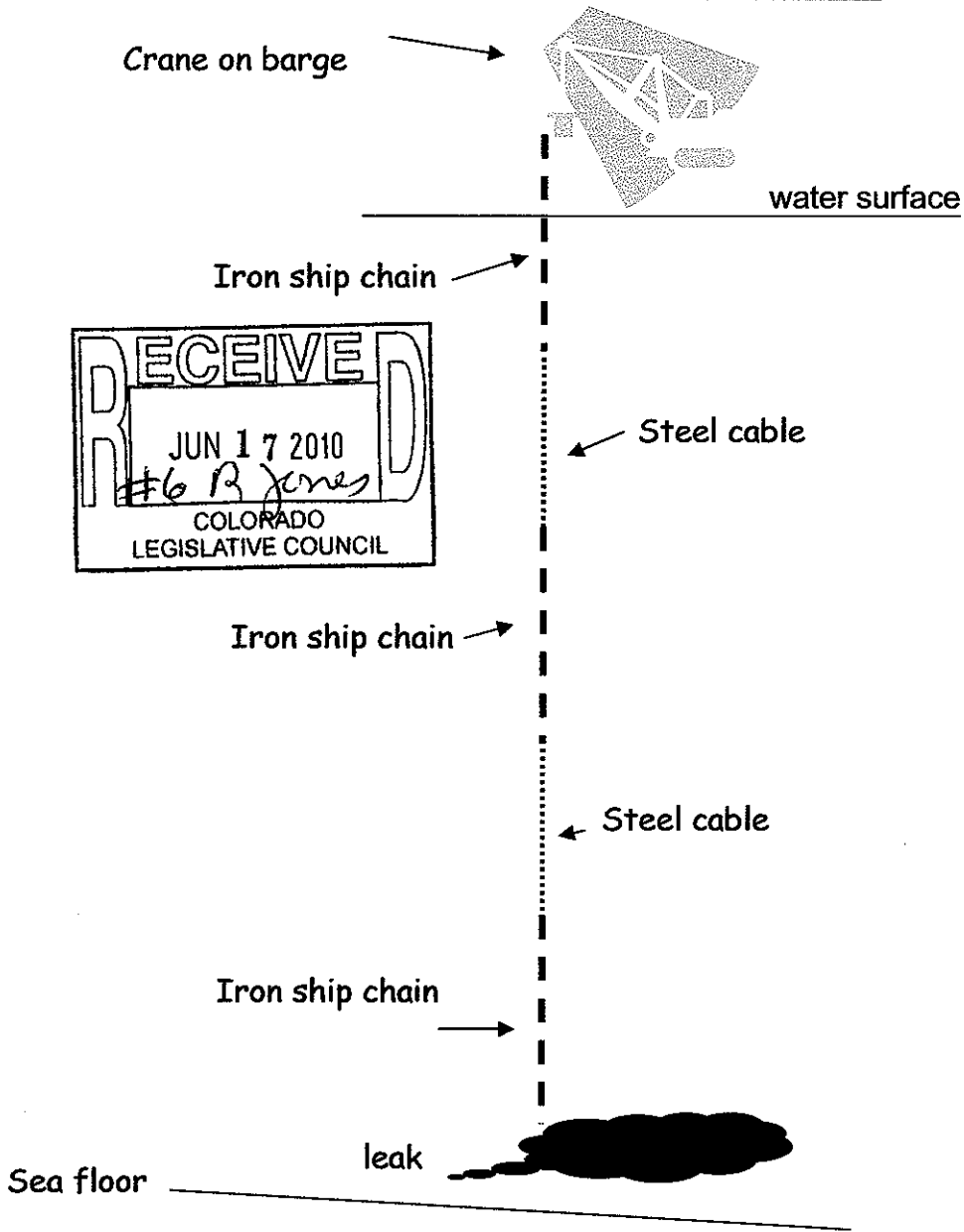
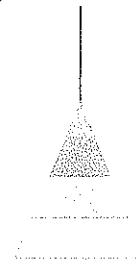


BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF COLORADO:
