Be it Enacted by the People of the State of Colorado:

Section 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, **repeal** and **reenact** part 2 of article 2 of title 1 as follows:

- **1-2-213. Registration at driver's license examination facilities.** (1) The department of revenue, through its local driver's license examination facilities, shall provide to the secretary of state records containing the legal name, age, residence, and citizenship information for, and the signature of, each eligible elector who applies for the issuance, renewal, or correction of any type of driver's license or for an identification card pursuant to part 3 of article 2 of title 42, C.R.S. (2) Upon receiving the record for a person described in subsection (1) of this section, the secretary of state shall provide the information to the county clerk of the county in which the person may be registered as an elector. The secretary or county clerk shall notify each person of the process to:
 - (a) Decline being registered as an elector.
 - (b) Adopt a political party affiliation.
- (3) If a person notified under subsection (2) of this section does not decline to be registered as an elector within 21 calendar days after the secretary of state or county clerk issues the notification, the person's record and signature submitted under subsection (1) of this section will constitute a completed application for registration. The person shall be registered to vote if the county clerk determines that the person is a qualified elector, and the person is not already registered to vote.
- (4) A county clerk may not send a ballot to, or add to an elector registration list, a person who meets eligibility requirements until at least 21 calendar days after the secretary of state or county clerk provided notification to the person as described in subsection (2) of this section.
- (5) The secretary of state and the department of revenue shall adopt rules necessary to implement this section.
- (6) The amendments to 1-2-213 by sections 1 through 5 of this 2016 initiative apply to records in the possession of the department of revenue on or after the effective date of this 2016 initiative.
