Dear Mike Mauer,

I would like to submit a draft to place a Colorado Constitutional amendment on the 2016 election ballot, see below for details on the amendment.

An amendment to Article 9 Bingo and Raffles Law 12-9-102. Definitions. As used in this article, unless the context otherwise requires: (1.7) "Charitable gaming" means bingo, pull tab games, and raffles, as defined in subsections (1), (18.1), and (19.3) of this section. And (7) "Game of chance" means that specific kind of game of chance commonly known as bingo or lotto in which prizes are awarded on the basis of designated numbers or symbols on a card conforming to numbers or symbols selected at random and that specific kind of game of chance commonly known as raffles that is conducted by drawing for prizes or the allotment of prizes by chance, by the selling of shares or tickets or rights to participate in such a game.

Amendment would be to add the game of Poker (ie: Texas Holdem, Omaha, 7 card stud or any other card games that are classified as a game of chance at this time) to the definitions of Charitable gaming and Game of chance.
