A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION COLLECTED PURSUANT TO**
102 **THE UNINSURED MOTORIST IDENTIFICATION DATABASE**
103 **PROGRAM.**

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not necessarily reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted.)

Clarifies that the department of revenue shall disclose motor vehicle insurance information only under the uninsured motorist identification database.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** 42-7-606 (1), Colorado Revised Statutes, is
3 amended to read:

4 **42-7-606. Disclosure of insurance information - penalty.**

5 (1) Information provided by insurers and the department for inclusion in
6 the database established pursuant to section 42-7-604 is the property of
7 the insurer or the department, as the case may be, and may not be
8 disclosed except as follows:

9 (a) The department shall verify a ~~person's~~ MOTOR VEHICLE'S
10 insurance coverage upon request by any state or local government agency
11 investigating, litigating, or enforcing such ~~person's~~ MOTOR VEHICLE'S
12 compliance with the financial security requirements.

13 (b) The department shall disclose whether ~~an individual~~ A MOTOR
14 VEHICLE has the required insurance coverage upon request by the
15 following individuals and agencies only:

16 (I) The ~~individual~~ OWNER;

17 (II) The parent or legal guardian of the ~~individual~~ OWNER if the
18 ~~individual~~ OWNER is an unemancipated minor;

19 (III) The legal guardian of the ~~individual~~ OWNER if the ~~individual~~
20 OWNER is legally incapacitated;

21 (IV) Any person who has power of attorney from the ~~individual~~
22 OWNER;

23 (V) Any person who submits a notarized release from the
24 ~~individual~~ OWNER that is dated no more than ninety days before the date
25 the request is made;

26 (VI) Any person suffering loss or injury in a motor vehicle
27 accident, ~~in which the individual is involved~~, but only as part of an

1 accident report authorized in part 16 of article 4 of this title; or

2 (VII) The office of the state auditor, for the purpose of conducting
3 any audit authorized by law.

4 **SECTION 2. Effective date.** This act shall take effect at 12:01
5 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period after
6 final adjournment of the general assembly that is allowed for submitting
7 a referendum petition pursuant to article V, section 1 (3) of the state
8 constitution, (August 8, 2007, if adjournment sine die is on May 9, 2007);
9 except that, if a referendum petition is filed against this act or an item,
10 section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section,
11 or part, if approved by the people, shall take effect on the date of the
12 official declaration of the vote thereon by proclamation of the governor.
