TITLE: CONCERNING THE APPLICATION OF COUNTY BUILDING CODE REQUIREMENTS TO STRUCTURES USED PRIMARILY FOR AGRICULTURAL PURPOSES.

Summary of Assessment

The bill creates a five-member task force to study any issues by the use of agricultural buildings as subject to county building code requirements, and to recommend legislation on these issues.

The first meeting is to be convened by the task force's chairperson. Task force members are not to be reimbursed for their expenses or compensated for their participation. The task force is required to reports its findings and recommendations to the House and Senate Agriculture Committees by January 15, 2008. The statutory authorization of this task force is scheduled for repeal on September 1, 2008. As both the House and Senate adhered to their disagreement, the bill was deemed lost.
