**Summary of Legislation**

This bill requires a local law enforcement agency that posts sex offender registration information on its website to also provide educational information on how people can protect themselves from sex offenders or a link to the educational information that is on the Colorado Bureau of Investigation's (CBI) website. Local governments that choose to post such information must work with the Sex Offender Management Board and sexual assault advocacy groups in preparing the information.

**State Expenditures**

The fiscal note assumes that most local governments will provide a link to the CBI's website. Moreover, if local governments choose to post the educational information, it is assumed that the additional work required of the Sex Offender Management Board will be minimal and absorbable within existing resources.

**Local Government Impact**

Local governments may incur additional costs to post information on internet websites on how individuals can protect themselves from sexual offenders. These costs are expected to be minimal.
